

Biodiversity Policy

Protecting and enhancing biodiversity is an integral part of TSPL & it is committed to sustainable development. Biodiversity is a complex phenomenon that needs to be identified, understood and valued from a biological and societal (i.e. in terms of ecosystem services) perspective and the company is conscious of the potential impacts and dependencies of its business on the environment in general and on biodiversity.

The Company is committed to integrating the need for biodiversity conservation within the operational decision-making processes and taking all necessary measures to minimise impact of their operations to the environment. The Company believes its performance on biodiversity conservation will create long term value for the business.

TSPL strives to:

- Prevent, minimise and mitigate biodiversity risks throughout the business. The Company will manage and use land in a manner that allows biodiversity conservation needs to be integrated with business needs through the project lifecycle, including decommissioning, closure and rehabilitation.
- Comply with and exceed, where possible, the local, regional and national legislative requirements on land management and biodiversity conservation.
- Identify and assess biodiversity status and value before the start of a new project and monitor impacts over the project lifecycle.
- Work towards the conservation of threatened/ rare and endemic species and high priority conservation areas and support local and national initiatives. The Company commits to providing information and raise awareness among its employees and other stakeholders to enhance knowledge and understanding of biodiversity and conservation issues where applicable.
- This policy will be reviewed regularly.
