TSPL strives to:

- Comply with applicable national and regional regulations
- Maintain a water balance that minimizes the amount of fresh water consumed by re-using as much water as possible in our processes and encouraging rainwater harvesting wherever possible
- Avoid pollution of surface water, ground water and other water resources arising from its operations. Apply a zero-discharge philosophy wherever possible and treat all wastewater to best practice before discharging to the environment
- Ensure that water and waste-storage facilities are engineered and maintained to good international standards
- Identify water conservation projects through reduction, recycling and reuse. To monitor progress against water consumption reduction targets across its businesses.
- Determine baselines and to develop water quality monitoring.
- This policy will be reviewed regularly.
